

Port Highlights



Halifax, founded in 1749, is a community and former city in the Canadian province of Nova Scotia. For most of its early history, Halifax was the primary North Atlantic base for the Royal Navy, it prospered during times of conflict and languished during times of peace. Sir Samuel Cunard, 1st Baronet was a Canadian born British shipping magnate. Cunard was born in Halifax, Nova Scotia, the son of a master carpenter and timber merchant who had fled the American Revolution and settled in Halifax. Samuel's business skills were evident at an early age and by age 17 he was managing his own general store. He later joined his father in the family timber business which he expanded into coal, iron, shipping and whaling. During the War of 1812, Cunard volunteered for service in the 2nd battalion of the Halifax Regiment of militia and rose to the rank of captain. A highly successful entrepreneur in Halifax shipping, Samuel Cunard went to the United Kingdom where he set up a joint venture with several other businessmen to bid on the rights to run a transatlantic shipping company between the UK and North America.



Guests do not need to carry their passports ashore today, your Queen Mary 2 guest identification card is sufficient. It is however, required that you carry some form of photographic identification.

Currency: Legal tender in Halifax is the Canadian Dollar. Canadian Dollar is not available onboard. Queen Mary 2 deals in US Dollars.

Postage: Postcards and letters can be posted via the Purser's Office. The postage cost in Halifax is \$2.15 per postcard/letter. If you already have a stamp on your letter or postcard we can still post it for you at the Purser's Office. This facility will close at 3.30pm and any post received after this time will only be posted in the following port.

Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your guest identification card with you when going ashore.

You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your guest identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

Canada Customs allowance (Tax and Duty Free Items)

Canadian Citizen/Resident: CAN\$800 worth of gifts per person, 1.5 litres of wine or 1.14 litres of alcoholic beverages or up to 8.5 litres of beer; 200 cigarettes, 50 cigars, 200 grams of manufactured tobacco and 200 tobacco sticks.

Non Canadian Citizens/Residents: Gifts (excludes alcohol and tobacco) valued at no more than CAN\$60 each; 1.5 litres of wine or 1.14 litres of alcoholic beverages or up to 8.5 litres of beer; 200 cigarettes, 50 cigars, 200 grams of manufactured tobacco and 200 tobacco sticks may be imported for personal use whilst in Canada. Otherwise, please refer to the allowances as per your country of final destination.
