

Port Highlights



Carved into the cliff of Cape Diamond, Québec City remains a stronghold of French culture, evident in the language, cuisine and European architecture. The city has some notable buildings including the Church of Notre-Dame-de-Québec and the imposing Chateau Frontenac, the most photographed hotel in the world. Nearby you can also visit the stunning Montmorency Falls and St. Anne de Beaupre Church, a beautiful basilica and one of the great pilgrimage sites of North America. Québec's forest covers more than 750,000km², which is the size of Sweden and Norway together. It represents 20% of the Canadian forests and 2% of the world's forests. Québec contains more than 3% of he world's fresh water reserves. This walled, old city - the only remaining in the US and Canada - is a living museum, each street a page in the book of French Canada's struggle for survival - even dominion - in British North America. Much of the city's past is still visible and its many churches, old stone houses and narrow streets make it an architectural gem. The jewel of Québec City is the Old Town, with its steep hills and staircases. Many hours may be whiled away exploring its charms.

Place your luggage outside your stateroom from 5.00 pm. We ask for your co-operation in placing any luggage outside early, even if you only have one case ready.

Cash payments

For guests disembarking in Québec City on 6 October please note the deadline of 10.00pm, today for the following services:

- Making a cash payment. After this deadline, all charges will be settled to the registered credit card. Please be advised that no cash will be refunded to your credit card.
- Charging cash back and/or foreign exchange to your on board account. Cash for cash foreign exchange facilities/transactions are available until the time of disembarkation on 6 October. Please note that failure to settle your account will result in delays to your disembarkation.

Preparing for your onward journey

We trust you've had an enjoyable and memorable time on board Queen Mary 2. The Purser's Office have written to all guests with important information about the disembarkation plans. All guests will have the option to disembark directly from their stateroom to the gangway at an allocated time, or to request Fast Track disembarkation. It is important that your allocated time is adhered to, avoiding potential crowds at the gangway area.

The Purser's Office are available on extension 22200 to assist with any queries, book mobility assistance and take requests for Fast Track disembarkation. Fast Track disembarkation spaces are limited and guests will be responsible for carrying all their luggage with them. The registration deadline for Fast Track disembarkation is 8.00pm this evening.

Ship's security notice

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your guest identification card with you when going ashore.

You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your guest identification card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the Security Staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship.

We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.
